World Bank Country Income Classification

This table shows the World Bank's 2021-22 classification of countries according to each nation's mean annual per capita income. For 2022, the annual membership payable by ICERS member will depend on the country of primary residence of a member. ISRS uses three classes, with the World Bank's low-income and low-middle-income categories grouped into a single class in the membership rates table.

The classification is revised annually by the World Bank, becoming operative on July 1st. Each year the new classification will be used to determine a member's subscription payable from the following October 1st.
